「國際學生學士班」招生簡介

國立臺灣大學中國文學系是歷史悠久的國際漢學研究重鎮。為進一步提供國際學生良好的中文學習環境，本系於 2008 年成立「國際學生學士班」。

本班以中文授課，每年預計招生 20 名，修業年限 4 年。教學方針主要有三方面：(一)語文學習——提供足夠的語文訓練，由淺入深，由現代白話到古代文言，希冀學生經過四年嚴格的語文訓練之後，能夠養成流利的中文聽、說、讀、寫能力。(二)文學薰陶——課程從現代文學到古典文學，由文學導論而專家選讀，循序漸進，使學生經過四年的薰陶，能深入瞭解中國文學的特質。(三)文化涵養——由最基本的文化概論開始，逐漸深入到古典文化之探究，使學生經過四年的學習，對中國文化傳統有更深刻的認識。

本班多元的課程設計，能夠滿足學生對中國文化的學習欲望，培養他們在中國語言、文學、學術思想、文獻資料的認知與研究能力，並冀望此一堅實的學術訓練與文化素養，可成為其日後從事語文教學或學術研究的基礎。

(一) 必修課程：

- 現代中文及習作一、二、三
- 古典詩文及習作一、二
- 中國文學史一、二
- 中國文化概論
- 漢語語言學
- 初級中國文字學（包括書法）
- 中國史地常識及中國文物與風俗
- 比較文化

(二) 選修課程：

- 文學、經學、語言文字及學術思想等四類約 40 門。
- 大部分選修課程與本地學生共同上課。

**Department of Chinese Literature

National Taiwan University's Department of Chinese Literature has a long history of being a stronghold for international Chinese research. In order to provide international students with an excellent environment to study Chinese, the NTU Department of Chinese Literature will begin offering a "Bachelor's Degree Program in Chinese Literature for International Students" in 2008.

The Bachelor's Degree Program in Chinese Literature for International Students will be taught in Chinese, with 20 students being admitted every year. Students will be required to spend at least four years within the program. The three major guiding principles of the program are as follows: (1) Language Study—the program will seek to provide adequate language training for students (training will progress from basic to in-depth and from modern to classical Chinese study) in the hope that after four years of intensive study students will attain aural and oral fluency as well as a high level of literacy and writing ability. (2) A Nurturing of Literary Knowledge—the curriculum will progress from modern to classical literary study and use chronologically ordered literature anthologies to help students achieve a deep knowledge of the Chinese literary style. (3) Cultural Development—starting from a basic cultural introduction and gradually exploring the depths of ancient culture, the program allows students to gain an in-depth understanding of Chinese cultural traditions.

The varied nature of this program's curriculum design is more than enough to satisfy students hoping to study Chinese culture and can also be used to cultivate students' knowledge and data collection skills in the areas of language, literature, academic training, and research materials. Furthermore, we hope that this substantial academic training and cultural cultivation will serve as a foundation for literary and language studies as well as academic research into the future.

(1) Required Courses

- Modern Chinese and Composition 1, 2, and 3
- Classical Chinese and Composition 1 and 2
- History of Chinese Literature 1 and 2
- Introduction to Chinese Culture
- Chinese Linguistics
- Introduction to Chinese Characters (Includes Calligraphy)
- Chinese History and Geography, Chinese Relics and Customs
- Comparative Cultural Studies

(2) Elective Courses:

- About forty courses are offered, including Literature, Classics, Linguistics and Scripts, as well as Academic Thought.
- Most of the Elective Courses are also attended by native students in Taiwan.
